We will also explore The Rites of Marriage and Holy Orders, in addition to the preparation for those children receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation which will take place on the 13th June 2019.</p>

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<p>This is what we will be teaching through our Foundation Subjects</p>	<p>Science – Animals (including humans) and Light During Science lessons, we will be looking at animals, being able to compare and contrast similarities or difference. Also during our lessons, we will examine the function of the lungs and heart. In addition, we will be covering the topic of Light. Looking at how light travels and how we see.</p> <p>Investigation Skills – These are key skills that allow the Children to predict outcomes, plan fair tests, observe and record results, present their results using Maths skills, and explain them in a clear and technically accurate way.</p> <p>ICT: Web Developer: how websites are created and maintained Digital Publisher: Desktop Publishing with the aim to create a Year Book for Y5/6 History: The Mayans The Children will learn about an Ancient Civilisation (Non-European) P.E.: Dance (English Country Dances) / Gymnastics (Holes and Counter-Balances) Athletics: Sprinting, longer-distance running, throwing, etc. in preparation for Sports Day, Art – Talking Textiles The children will investigate, design and make a group textile that tells a story.</p> <p>D.T. – We will start by completing the practical aspects of the topics covered last term. This will include making a clay container and bread making. Once these topics have been completed, we will cover the topic Fairground.</p> <p>Music – Dancing in the Street. Leading into a topic that is called Reflect, Rewind and Replay.</p> <p>MFL: Continue making advances with their study of German.</p>
