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| St Cecilia Assembly 5 th October 2018 Class Mass 24 th October 2018 | Our topics will be: Creation - Miracles and The Sacrament of the Sick - Advent - Christmas Within RE lessons we will be exploring the Creation , where we introduce the children to the story of creation as a way of explaining that God is creator, rather than a re-telling of the order of the created world. Miracles and the Sacrament of the Sick is a crucial unit for the development of pupils as members of the Church Community. They will learn about some of the miracles of Jesus and the work of the Church to heal and care for the sick in Christ's name. |

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| | <p>We have a Literacy lesson each day, in which your child will take part in both reading and writing activities and will gain experience of a selection of different text types and writing styles. Each week the children will take part in a guided reading lesson where they will practise a variety of reading skills.</p> <p>They will also have opportunities to read independently at certain times, so will therefore need to remember to bring their books to school daily. However, it is still very important that they have the opportunity to take part in <u>reading activities outside school</u>, and I stress the importance of your child reading as often as possible at home – this does not always have to be their school reading book. Please can children regularly record their responses to their reading in Reading Record Books. They are to be handed in to the box in class for checking.</p> <p>We practise spellings or handwriting each morning at 8.45, so it is important your child is on time and can start learning at the earliest opportunity.</p> | <p>Daily Numeracy lesson cover all areas of Mathematics, your child will also have to practise Arithmetic, in which they will be taught to develop their calculation speed, accuracy and knowledge of successful strategies.</p> <p>Your child will be set homework via the MyMaths website – this fantastic resource will guide your child as well as testing their understanding and has the facility to use the screens we use in class to teach concepts to help to reinforce their school work at home. I ask that you encourage your child to do this often as possible.</p> <p>If you currently do not have Internet access at home, your child will be given the opportunity to complete homework within school time.</p> <p>MyMaths can be accessed on IOS and Android tablets via the Puffin Academy App</p> <p>A timetable test will take place – they may not be weekly as some weeks will focus on times table practice.</p> |
